

## DEPT. 26 - OPEN CLOTHING

JUDGING: Tuesday, 9:00 a.m.

- **Entries can be brought in between 3:00 –5:00 p.m. Sunday or 11:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. on Monday**
- All articles must be the work of the exhibitor, and must not have been exhibited previously at the Washington County Fair. May be worn before exhibiting but must be clean and pressed.
- All exhibits must be on standard wire hangers. For heavy items, use two (2) or more hangers taped together and padded if you wish. Do not use plastic hangers. Please attach your entry tag to the upper right hand corner of the garment as you look at it, using a safety pin. (For delicate fabrics, pin in the seam line to avoid pin holes). Please use spring-type clothes pins for attaching skirts, etc. Items such as purses, bags, hats, headwear and dolls do not require a hanger.
- No knitted or crocheted items to be entered in the department.
- **Exhibit items to be picked up Sunday between 7pm-9pm.**

### DIVISION A - Adult Clothing (older than 12 years old)

**Class No. Premiums: \$1.75 - \$1.50 - \$1.25 - \$1.00**

1. Accessory to be worn i.e. ties, scarf, collar
2. Head covering – Bridal veil, cap, hat Formal dress
3. Sleeveless or strapless top
4. Sweatshirt or T-shirt
5. Top with sleeves
6. Tote/purse – everyday use
7. Tote/purse – special occasion
8. Vest
9. Apron

**Class No. Premiums: \$2.00 - \$1.75 - \$1.50 - \$1.25**

10. Any lingerie
11. Blouse or shirt
12. Dress
13. Garment made by first time exhibitor
14. Pants
15. Skirt
16. Sleepwear

**Class No. Premiums: \$2.50 - \$2.25 - \$2.00 - \$1.75**

17. Fleece jacket, coat or blazer
18. Outfit, 2 piece top and skirt, top and pant, etc
19. Robe or Housecoat

**Class No. Premiums: \$4.50 - \$3.50 - \$2.50 - \$1.50**

20. Any garment featuring machine embroidery
21. Any garment featuring hand stitchery – i.e. smocking, embroidery
22. Any patchwork garment
23. Any quilted garment
24. Bridal Gown/dress
25. Costume
26. Lined coat or blazer
27. Special Occasion dress or pant dress, not bridal
28. Suit or pant suit, 2 or more pieces
29. Unlined jacket, coat blazer, not fleece

**Division B - Child's Clothing (2-12 years old)**

**Class No. Premiums: \$2.00 - \$1.75 - \$1.50 - \$1.25**

1. Head covering, i.e. Hat or Cap
2. Any completely hand sewn garment or item children's use
3. Any sewn garment featuring hand stitchery – i.e. smocking, embroidery, machine embroidery
4. Any bought garment featuring machine or hand embroidery
5. Pants, any length
6. Top
7. Coat/Jacket
8. Costume
9. Dress
10. Garment for Special Occasion
11. Outfit, 2 pc
12. Sleepwear
13. Adult & Child or sibling –any matching garment, not listed
14. Child & Doll coordinating outfits

**Division C –Infant and Toddler (up to 2 years old)**

**Class No. Premiums: \$2.00 - \$1.75 - \$1.50 - \$1.25**

1. Hat or Cap
2. Any sewn garment or item for infant and toddler use.
3. 2 or more piece outfit
4. Any garment sewn featuring hand stitchery - i.e. smocking, embroidery
5. Any bought garment featuring machine or hand embroidery
6. Coat or Jacket
7. Costume
8. Sleepwear
9. Snowsuit/bunting
10. Special Occasion Outfit
11. 2 or more outfits for dolls or bear—any size, may include doll/bear for display purpose.

**Division D—Classes offered to youth 18 or under**

**Class No. Premiums: \$2.00-\$1.75-\$1.50-\$1.25**

1. Any article of clothing made by youth 14 or under
2. Any article of clothing made by youth 18 or under
