DIVISION A - Bees and Honey

All exhibits in this division must be the product from the apiary of the exhibitor.

All comb honey should be wrapped in cellophane and frames filled with honey to be protected by glass or wrapped cellophane.

Class No. Premiums: \$2.50, \$2.25, \$2.00, \$1.50

1. Extracted White Honey 2 each - 8 oz. jars. Or 2 each - 1 lb. jars (clear container)
2. Extracted Golden Honey 2 each - 8 oz. jars Or 2 each - 1 lb. jars (clear container)
3. Extracted Dare Honey 2 each - 8 oz. jars Or 2 each - 1 lb. jars (clear container)
4. One comb of honey

Class No. Premiums: \$5.50, \$4.50, \$3.50, \$2.50

5. Three banded bees with Queen, in single frame observatory hive with glass on both sides

Class No. Premiums: \$1.75, \$1.50, \$1.25, \$1.00

6. Most attractive display of beeswax, not less than 5 lbs.

Food exhibits (cakes, cookies, candy) made with honey must be entered under Dept. 25 Division L, exhibitors must follow entry day, time and instruction in that department.

DIVISION B - Maple Syrup

Food Exhibits (cakes, cookies, candy) made with maple syrup are to be entered under Dept. 25 DIVISION N; Exhibitors must follow entry day, time and instruction in that department.

Entries must be made before June 30th of exhibit year. Container may be opened for judging. Jar must have ring in place. Can be exhibited in either a pint or quart jar. Must be labeled with process date on jar.

Class No. Premiums \$2.50, \$2.25, \$2.00, \$1.50

1. Light Maple syrup in 16 oz. or 1 quart glass container sealed with lid and ring.
2. Dark Maple syrup in 16 oz. or 1 quart glass container sealed with lid and ring.
