JUDGING: Friday, Immediately after the Open Class Show

- All Dairy animals must be brought in between 2:00pm and 6:00pm Tuesday.
- Animals entered by Junior Exhibitors must be stalled in the Dairy Barn with their clubs display.
- Junior Club displays must only include animals entered in Junior Class
- Any animals entered by a Junior Exhibitor must be shown by that Exhibitor, unless they become unable to show due to health, injury, or other concern. Another Junior Exhibitor may show the animal after consultation and approval of the Superintendent.
- Animals must be body clipped prior to coming to Fair.
- Clubs can provide their own gates or small square bales to separate the animals (no more than 2 high).
- All feed and bedding must be neatly stored in designated outside tack areas.
- All animals should be escorted with a catch pan for manure during Fair open visiting hours.

15. Purebred 2 year old cow, Born September 1, 2016 – August 31, 2017, Must be in milk
16. Grade 2 year old cow, Born September 1, 2016 – August 31, 2017, Must be in milk
17. Purebred 3 year old cow, Born September 1, 2015 – August 31, 2016, Must be in milk
18. Grade 3 year old cow, Born September 1, 2015 – August 31, 2016, Must be in milk
19. Purebred 4 year old & over cow, Born before August 31, 2015, Must be in milk
20. Grade 4 year old & over cow, Born before August 31, 2015, Must be in milk
21. Purebred dry cow, any cow that has completed at least 1 lactation, not currently in milk
22. Grade dry cow, any cow that has completed at least 1 lactation, not currently in milk

Trophy awards for the best udder in memory of Walter Schwendimann. There will be champions selected in the Holstein breed and in a combination of all colored breeds, purebred or grade animals. A total of 7 champions will be picked. Four of them will be heifer champions and three champions for cows.

DIVISION H- Herdsmanship Award

Class No. Premiums: \$5 - \$4 - \$3 - \$2

1. Dairy (small clubs with nine or less animals)
2. Dairy (large clubs with ten or more animals)

This entry is for CLUBS or CHAPTERS. An exhibitor should check with their club or chapter before June 30 to be sure they are entered. An exhibitor does NOT need to list this division on their entry form. Premiums will be awarded for keeping the animals on exhibit in neat appearance, the feed, the straw, hay bales and boxes in the proper place and the walkways in the barn in good order and appearance. Any decorations erected including barn cards will be considered in the Judging. All decorations must be removed before any premiums will be paid.

**DIVISION I - Dairy Showmanship
(Danish)**

Judging will be done on individual basis. Exhibitor must be dressed in all white. Hard tipped shoes recommended. State Fair dairy exhibitors are required to be in showmanship. Premiums will be as follows:

Class No. Premiums: \$3, \$2.50, \$2, \$1.50

1. Beginners, 8-11 years
2. Intermediate, 12-14 years
3. Senior, 15 years and over

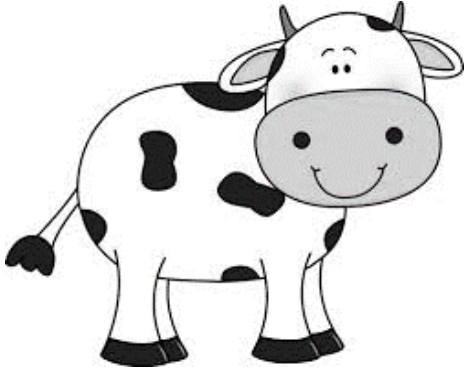

3. Item of equipment made by member for care of Dairy Cattle (must be different article than Class 1 & 2)
4. Second item of equipment, made by member, for care of Dairy Cattle (must be different article than Class 1-3)

Half Pint Showmanship Contest



The Washington County Dairy Promotion Committee sponsors the Half Pint Showmanship Contest on Sunday, July 28, 2019 at 1:00pm at the Washington County Fair Park Farm Progress Arena.

The contest is open to children 5 to 9 years old that are not yet enrolled in 4-H. Participants will use a calf born after January 1, 2019. Prizes will be awarded to all participants.

Children/Parents will be required to make arrangements to use one of the Junior or Open Dairy Calves that is already at the Fairgrounds as there is not room for additional animals in the barn. Children will be divided into groups based on the participation level and at the discretion of the Dairy Superintendents.

Children will be judged on their basic showmanship skills. The comments made by the judge will include tips on improving these skills. Ribbons will be awarded to all participants.

Parents should come to the Farm Progress Arena 1 hour before the contest to help set up the ring and walk way. There is also a mandatory meeting 30 minutes before the event start time. Back tags and programs will be handed out.
