- Dogs are to be brought to the fairgrounds for the show and be taken home after the show.
- Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times, except while being judged. Exhibitors must keep dogs under control at all times.
- At the Superintendent and Judges Discretion, animals not under control shall be removed from the show.
- All dogs must have distemper and parvo shots within year of show day. Rabies shots must be current.
- Showmanship classes will be judged first with Obedience to follow after lunch.
- No dog in season may compete in obedience or showmanship.
- No changes will be allowed the day of the show.

DIVISION A - Dog Obedience

Class No. Premiums: \$4.50, \$3.50, \$2.50, \$1.50

1. Beginner Pre-Novice A, first time handler is showing in pre-novice. First time dog is being shown in pre-novice.
2. Beginner Pre-Novice B, any handler showing a dog which failed to qualify in beginner pre-novice the previous year.
3. Pre-Novice A, first time handler is showing in pre-novice. First time dog is being shown in pre-novice.
4. Pre-Novice B, handler who has shown in pre-novice before, with a dog who is being shown for the first time or any handler showing a dog which failed to qualify in pre-novice the previous year.
5. Novice - Off lead
6. Graduate novice
7. Pre-Open
8. Open
9. Pre-Utility
10. Utility
11. Pre-Novice Team Obedience
12. Novice Team Obedience
13. Rally – Novice
14. Rally - Intermediate
15. Rally - Advanced
16. Rally - Excellent

*When a dog receives a qualifying score in any division, it must progress to the next level of training and be shown in the next division in future shows.

DIVISION B - Dog Showmanship

Class No. Premiums: \$3.00, \$2.50, \$2.00, \$1.50

Observe divisions carefully so you enter the right division. If you are a first-year member who has not qualified for Open Jr. or Open Sr. at AKC shows, you belong in the First Year Division in the age group that you fit in. In order to qualify for Open Jr. or Open Sr., you must have won 3 firsts in AKC shows with competition in your Division. If you have your 3 AKC wins you must enter Open Jr., Open intermediate or Open Sr. divisions even if it is your first year. If during the year before Fair entries are due you get your 3 wins, you must enter the Open Divisions.

First year dog project member. No previous dog show experience.

1. First year 8-11
2. First year 12 and over

Best Jr. Handler trophy and reserve.

Best Jr. Handler rosette first year members only.

Jr. Showmanship Divisions

3. Novice Jr. 8-11 (not qualified for Open Jr. at AKC shows)
4. Novice Intermediate 12-14 (not qualified for Open Jr. at AKC shows)
5. Novice Senior 15 & over (not qualified for Open Jr. at AKC shows)
6. Open Jr. 8-11 (eligible to compete in Open Jr. at AKC shows)
7. Open Intermediate 12-14 (eligible to compete in Open Jr. at AKC shows)
8. Open Senior 15 & over (eligible to compete in Open Jr. at AKC shows)

Best Jr. Handler Trophy and Reserve Best Jr. Handler Rosette for advanced Novice and Open Divisions only.

Best overall trophy and rosette for reserve for both divisions.

Best Jr. Handler in first year and best Advanced Jr. Handler competes for this trophy.

The Reserve winner from whatever division is chosen best overall is eligible to come in ring for reserve best overall and compete with best Jr. Handler from other division.
