Entry Fee: \$20.00 per tractor
Weigh In: Washington County Fair Park, 3000 Hwy PV, West Bend, WI.
9:00 -11:30 am. Scale closes at 11:30 am SHARP – NO EXCEPTIONS

Each tractor may pull once – no jumping classes. The same driver may enter multiple tractors.
Applications for Tractor Pull available the day of the pull.

Farm Classes:

Prizes: 1st Place \$75, 2nd Place \$50, 3rd Place \$35, 4th Place \$25

Class AA	4,500 lbs	45 hp Antique – 14.9x38 max tire size
Class BB	6,000 lbs	60 hp Antique – 16.9x38 max tire size
Class A	6,500 lbs	56 PTO hp manufacturer estimated limit No turbo chargers allowed. 18.4x38 max tire size
Class B	8,500 lbs	73 PTO hp manufacturer estimated limit No turbo chargers allowed. 18.4x38 max tire size
Class C	10,500 lbs	86 PTO hp manufacturer estimated limit Max turbo inlet no larger than 1.63". Non turbo tractors can weigh 11,500 lbs. 18.4x38 max tire size
Class D	12,000 lbs.	96 PTO hp manufacturer estimated limit Non-Turbo 410 cubic inch max. Stock core injection pump, factory fueled. 18.4x38 max tire size. No engine side shields unless factory equipped
Class E	13,500 lbs	Non Turbo – No horse power limit
Class F	14,500 lbs	Turbo or non-turbo - No horse power limit

Additional Farm Class Rules:

1. Stock RPM's and factory fueled
2. Throttles will be checked at weigh in
3. No cut tires
4. No add on HP boost of any kind injected into the engine
5. Class AA thru class F open to 2 wheel drive tractors with stock block
6. Class B tractors with add on turbos must pull in class C
7. Class C tractors with add on turbos must pull in class F
8. Pullers will be responsible for removing hose to check turbo size
9. No reduce sleeves in turbo inlets. Factory stock turbo size. Max inlet of 1.63" in Class C
10. 18 inch maximum drawbar height in Classes AA, BB, A, B and C
11. 20 inch maximum drawbar height in Classes D, E and F
12. Tractor must be equipped with a clevis or pulling eye

Note: These rules are set up to give every entered tractor an honest and fair chance of placing in their class. Do not try to abuse these rules to gain a competitive edge. Questions – 920-717-2255
