JUDGING: Friday, immediately after the Open Class Show (8:30am)

- All Dairy animals must be brought in between 2:00pm and 6:00pm Tuesday.
- Animals entered in a club as Junior entries must be tied or stalled in the dairy barn with their Clubs display.
- Any animals entered by a Junior Exhibitor must be shown by that Exhibitor, unless they become unable to show due to health, injury, or other concern. Another Junior Exhibitor may show the animal after consultation and approval of the Superintendent.
- The animal must be kept in the display area of their person entering the animal.
- Exhibits must be Junior division animals only. Open division animals may not be mixed with Junior division.
- Animals must be body clipped prior to coming to the Fair.
- Straw and Hay must be stored in overhang.

DAIRY CATTLE DEFINITIONS:

1. A Spring calf is one born between March 1, 2023 and May 31, 2023 (Spring calves must have some identification)
2. A winter calf is one whose date of birth is between December 1, 2022 and February 28, 2023.
3. A fall calf is one whose date of birth is between September 1, 2022 and November 30, 2022.
4. A summer yearling is one whose date of birth is between June 1, 2022 and August 31, 2022.
5. A spring yearling is one whose date of birth is between March 1, 2022 and May 31, 2022.
6. A winter yearling is one whose date of birth is between December 1, 2021 and February 28, 2022
7. A fall yearling is one whose birth is between September 1, 2021 and November 30, 2021.
8. A 2-year-old is one born between September 1, 2020 and August 31, 2021. A 2 year includes a yearling which has freshened.
9. A 3-year-old is one whose date of birth is between September 1, 2019 and August 31, 2020.
10. A 4-year-old is one whose date of birth is between September 1, 2018 and August 31, 2019, or older.
11. A 5-year-old is one whose date of birth is before 2017.

DIVISION I - Herdsmanship Award

Class No. Premiums: \$5.00, \$4.00, \$3.00, \$2.00

1. Dairy (small clubs with nine or less animals)
2. Dairy (large clubs with ten or more animals)

This entry is for CLUBS or CHAPTERS. An exhibitor should check with their club or chapter before June 30 to be sure they are entered. An exhibitor does NOT need to list this division on their entry form. Premiums will be awarded for keeping the animals on exhibit in neat appearance, the feed, the straw, hay bales and boxes in the proper place and the walkways in the barn in good order and appearance. Any decorations erected including barn cards will be considered in the Judging. All decorations must be removed before any premiums will be paid.

DIVISION J - Dairy Showmanship (Danish)

Judging will be done on individual basis. Exhibitor must be dressed in all white. Hard tipped shoes recommended. State Fair dairy exhibitors are required to be in showmanship. Premiums will be as follows:

Class No. Premiums: \$3.00, \$2.50, \$2.00, \$1.50

1. Beginners, 8-11 years
2. Intermediate, 12-14 years
3. Senior, 15 years and over

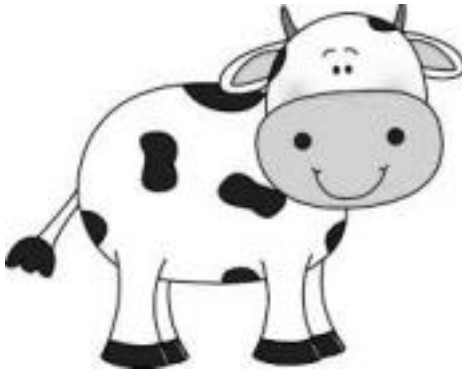
1. Educational Poster, recommended size 12" x 22"

The Washington County Dairy Promotion Committee will sponsor a “Half Pint” Showmanship Contest on Sunday July 30th at 1:00pm at the Washington County Fair Park Farm Progress Arena. The contest is open to children 5-9 years old that are not old enough to have a dairy fair entry. Participants will use a calf born after January 1, 2023. The animals are to be on the Fairgrounds as of Tuesday. Prizes will be awarded to all participants.

Application Forms and permission slips need to be returned by June 30th, to the Name and Address listed on the Application Form.

Half Pint Showmanship Contest



The Washington County Dairy Promotion Committee sponsors the Half Pint Showmanship Contest on Sunday, July 30th at 1:00pm at the Washington County Fair Park Farm Progress Arena.

The contest is open to children 5 - 8 years old that are not yet old enough to have a livestock fair entry. Participants will use a calf born after January 1, 2023. Prizes will be awarded to all participants.

Children/parents/guardians will be required to make arrangements to use one of the Junior or Open Dairy calves that are already at the Fairgrounds. Children will be divided into groups based on the participation level and at the discretion of the Dairy Superintendents.

Children will be judged on their basic showmanship skills. The comments made by the judge will include tips on improving these skills. Ribbons will be awarded to all participants.

Parents should come to the Farm Progress Arena 1 hour before the contest to help set up the ring and walkway. There is also a mandatory meeting 30 minutes before the event start time. Back tags and programs will be handed out.

All applications and permission slips are due no later than June 30th. Please return your completed and signed Application and Permission Slip below to the Washington County Fair Office (3000 Hwy PV, West Bend, WI 53095).
