DIVISION A - Horse/Horseless Horse Non-Animal Educational Exhibits

Judging will be face-to-face. Recommended poster size 14" x 22", display board 18" x 22"; science board acceptable.

Premiums: \$1.75, \$1.50, \$1.25, \$1.00

Class No.

1. Poster; Safe habits to use when around horses
2. Poster; Diseases/parasites; causes, medications, and prevention
3. Poster; Flow chart Parasite Life Cycle, Disease staging, etc.
4. Poster; Identify parts of saddle/bridle (English or Western)
5. Poster; Identify equipment used for Western Pleasure riding
6. Poster; Identify equipment used for English Equitation
7. Poster; Identify the parts of the horse
8. Poster; Display Identifying parts of Horse Hoof Parts
9. Poster; Reproduction, and growth (photos may be used)
10. Poster/Booklet on History of a Breed
11. Poster/Booklet; identifying markings of a horse (drawings or pictures)
12. Poster/Booklet of careers in horse field

Unit 1 - Only open to members enrolled in Veterinary Science Unit 1 "The Normal Animal" or doing equivalent work.

1. Poster or Chart relating to animal health
2. Poster or Chart relating to animal sanitation
3. Poster or Chart relating to cells, tissues, and/or systems of the animal body
4. Any other exhibit not listed above

Unit 2 – Only open to members enrolled in Veterinary Science Unit 2 "Animal Disease" or doing equivalent work.

Class No. Premiums: \$1.75, \$1.50, \$1.25, \$1.00

5. Poster or Chart relating to animal disease, bacteria and/or viruses
6. Poster or Chart relating to external or internal parasites
7. Poster or Chart relating to nutrition, stress, or heredity

Unit 3 - Only open to members enrolled in Veterinary Science Unit 3 "Immunology, Zoonosis and Health Immunology" or doing equivalent work.

3. A written report and picture researching breed information on your pet.
4. An educational display using photography or art to reflect your pet's personality.
