

## **DEPT. 133 - YOUTH LEADERSHIP/SELF DETERMINED**

**Superintendent - Jan Heidtke**

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**JUDGING:** Monday, 1:00pm to 7:00pm

- Exhibitor must be enrolled as a youth leader for project or in the youth leadership project.
- Exhibit must be from current project year.
- Face to face judging will be used.
- Limit of two entries per member per division for Youth Leadership (Division A and Division B) Four entries total.
- Member must have used the exhibit in the project area or leadership role.
- All posters 14" x 22"; display boards 18" x 24" (approximate tri-fold size); science boards 36" x 48" (approximate flat size).

### **DIVISION A - Youth Enrolled in the Youth Leadership Project**

**Class No. Premiums: \$3.00, \$2.50, \$2.00, \$1.50**

1. A poster showing how you have grown as a youth leader. For example: (a) new leadership role such as camp counselor or club officer. (b) Explanation of how adult leaders and youth leaders can work together on a specific project or activity.
2. Develop a computer-generated informational presentation about your youth leadership role, minimum of 15 to 20 slides. (Use Microsoft Power Point or similar software. Can be presented via DVD or computer disc/ USB drive for judging.)
3. Any project or activity illustrating community service or community outreach.
4. A 5–10-minute video of you leading an activity at a club, county or statewide event that is not project related.
5. Any other exhibit from a youth leadership project or activity approved by the club youth leadership project leader, the Dept. Superintendent or by County 4-H Youth Development Educator.

### **DIVISION B – Youth Enrolled as a Youth Leader in a Project**

**Class No. Premiums: \$2.50, \$2.25, \$2.00, \$1.75**

1. A series of actual samples exhibitor used to teach during a 4-H project meeting –must be samples to show the steps in learning something.
2. Any learning game or activity that exhibitor used as a method to get younger members involved in doing something at a project meeting (Exhibit can be the actual game or a poster with pictures and an explanation)
3. A planned and written outline for a series of project meetings in a specific project. (Include photos of you teaching the outline)
4. A 5–10-minute video of you teaching at a project meeting.
5. Any poster showing an activity you led or shows a game or activity you taught.
6. Any other exhibit used as a youth leader in a project or activity approved by the club project leader, the Dept. Superintendent or by the County 4-H Youth Development Educator.

## **DIVISION C- Self Determined/Service Learning**

### **Class No. Premiums: \$2.50, \$2.25, \$2.00, \$1.75**

1. A booklet or scrapbook describing what was done or learned in this project
2. A poster showing what was done or learned in this project
3. A display showing what was done or learned in this project (no animals allowed)
4. Article made by exhibitor while exploring new interest
5. Original video/DVD, 3 or more minutes in length, showing an interest shared at a 4-H meeting
6. A model related to this project
7. Any other exhibit relating to project

### **Self-Determined-Collections**

Describe each collection entry; describe work done in current years or information and/or articles added for current year. All collections to include a 3 x 5 card describing each hobby.

8. Stamp Collection, mounted, labeled (in protective pages)
9. Coin Collection, mounted, labeled
10. Baseball Card Collection
11. Football Card Collection
12. Any other collection or display
